PICOLA Necklace Tutorial Instruction


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Materials

Czech small dagger beads 3x11 (DGS)

Czech Lentil center hole beads size 6mm (DSK)  or Mini Drop Instead

Miyuki Drop beads size 3.4 (DRP)

Miyuki Bugle beads size 2# 6mm (BG6)

Miyuki Round seed beads size 8/0 (R8)

Miyuki Round seed beads size 11/0 (R11)

Miyuki Tila beads (TL)

Fireline 6lb or similar

12# needle

Magnetic clasp



Level: Beginner – Intermediate

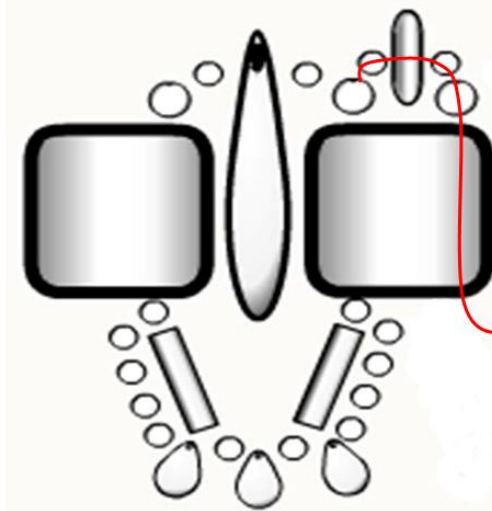
Length: 19 inch

Introduction:

Start with a comfortable thread length. I recommend about 5 feet (about 1.50 meter) for starting. String a stopper bead leaving about 4" (10 cm) tail. Go through the stopper bead twice to anchor the bead. (Stopper bead is an 11/0 round seed beads different color from those you are working with. This bead will remove at the end of our work.)

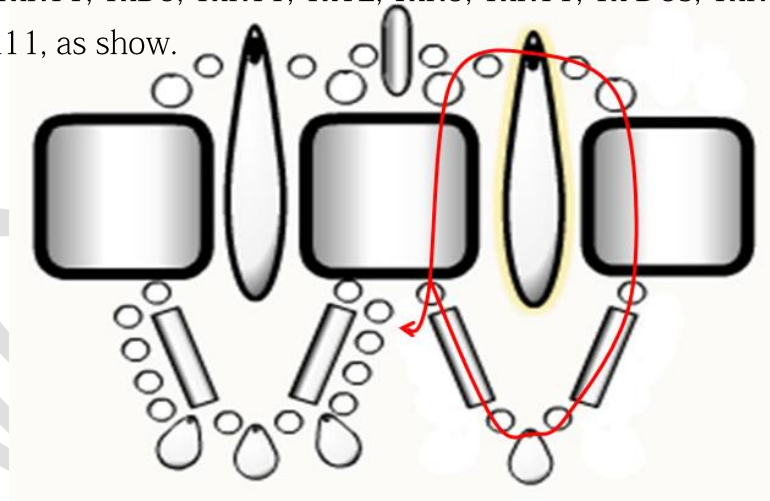
Step 4

Pick up 1xR11, 1xDISK (or DP), 1xR11, 1xR8. Go down through the nearest free TL hole, as show.



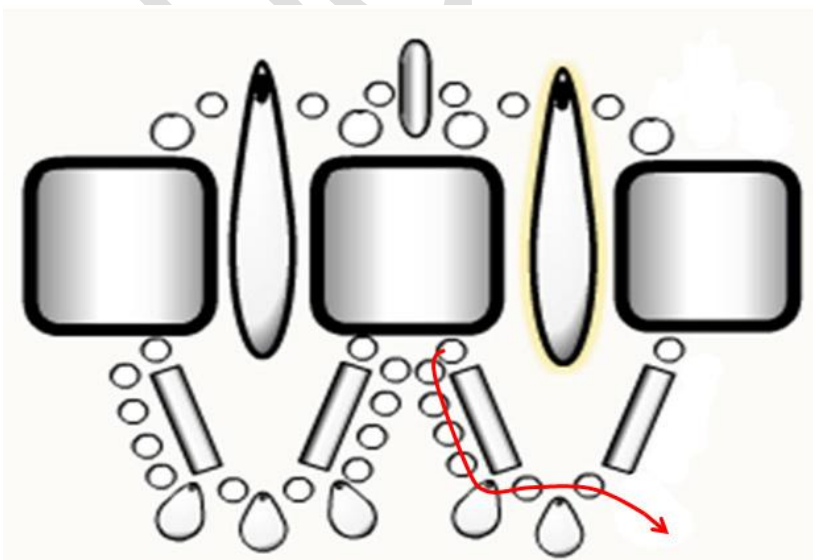
Step 5

Pick up 1xR11, 1xBG, 1xR11, 1xDRP, 1xR11, 1xBG, 1xR11, 1xTL, 1xR8, 1xR11, 1x DGS, 1xR11., Close them on the previous R8, TL & R11, as show.



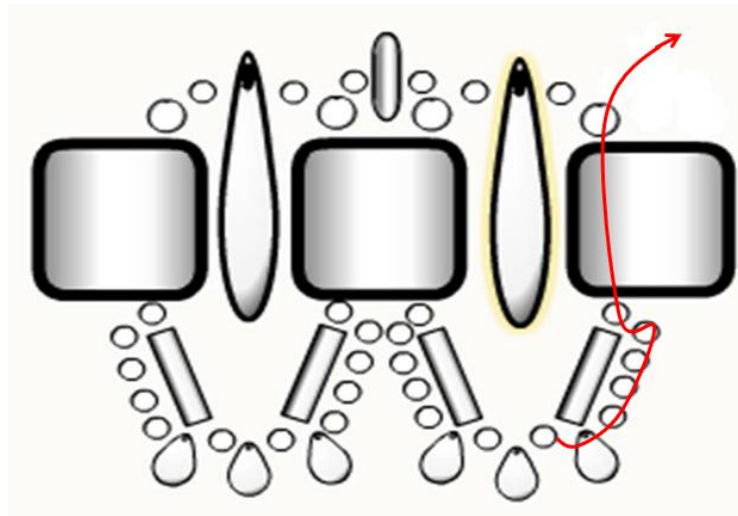
Step 6

Pick up 4xR11, 1xDRP. Go down through the R11 located after the BG & R11 (skip the previous drop), as show. Similar to Step 2.



Step 7

Pick up 1xDRP, 4xR11. Go up through the R11 located under the TL. Continue through TL located above and the R8, as show. Similar to step 3.



***Repeat step 4, step 5, step 6 & step 7 until you reach the desire length.

- Finish the thread, add the clasp and.....

That's It!!!
